

Hendricks Decal Installation

Hendricks decals are applied the same as the old model airplane decals. Cut around each group of text or symbols you wish to apply, leave a border. It doesn't have to be perfect as the background film is transparent. The decals are easiest to apply to a bare chassis, so have your knobs or any close components handy to see what clearance you need. It is easy to apply a decal only to have a portion of it covered up at final assembly.

Place the decal in lukewarm water for 10 seconds. Handle carefully to avoid tearing. Gently slide the decal into place on location. Use a damp cloth to wipe excess water. Remove any bubbles by wiping gently to the sides. Allow to set 3 hours, or speed drying by placing near a fan. When dry, spray Krylon clear to seal and protect the decals, and allow to dry. All decals come with two complete sets, in case you mess one up.
